All wind players, guitarists, pianists, and bassists will prepare the following 3 (or 4) excerpts.

- 1) Etude #1 2) Shiny Stockings 3) Stop Time Blues 4)Optional improvised solo
- 1) All-Region Etude #1 (from the Texas All-State Jazz Etudes in a previous year)
 - a) Sax (Flute and Clarinet use this too) Sax Etude #1 play beginning to double bar (meas. 9)
 - b) Trumpet Trumpet Etude #1 play beginning to eighth rest in meas. 9
 - c) Trombone Trombone Etude #1 play beginning to end of meas. 10
 - d) Guitar Guitar Etude #1 play beginning to first note of meas. 9
 - e) Piano **Piano Etude #1** play beginning to end of meas. 9 (NOTE-> right hand plays melody while left hand plays chords)
 - f) Bass Bass Etude #1 play beginning to end of meas. 8
- 2) Shiny Stockings by Frank Foster (Count Basie Big Band, classic melody)
 - a) Guitar play the melody of **Shiny Stockings** (1st X) AND then the chords (2nd X)
 - b) Piano play the melody of **Shiny Stockings** in right hand while playing chords in left hand
- 3) Stop Time Blues by Jamey Aebersold (from Vol. 70 'Killer Joe' in the Jamey Aebersold play-a-long series)
 - a) Bass-Play melody 1st X, then play a 'walking' bass line 2nd X
- 4) OPTIONAL perform an improvised solo with the play-a-long recording for 'Stop Time Blues'

All drum set players will prepare the following:

- 1. Have You Met Miss Jones? play from beginning to letter 'C' with the recording
- 2. 16 measures of medium swing (play 'time') in 4/4
- 3. 16 measures of samba in 2/2 (cut-time)
- 4. 16 measures of funk in 4/4
- 5. 16 measures of fast swing (play 'time) in 4/4
